At this time approximately over 1200 enrollees in the Basic Social Intelligence, Advanced Social Intelligence, and Leaders Without Titles have expressed interests in further study in these subjects.

**Personnel Impact:** The class will be taught by Stephen J. Sampson, Ph.D. As the program grows, instructors will be drawn from individuals across the University who are qualified to teach under EKU Policy 4.61P, and who reflect the basic principles of social intelligence and leadership.
